- Pray them at various times throughout the day.
- Join the Zoom call at 7:00pm for a prayer time led by Pastor Eric.

### **Prayer Prompts:**

Begin with giving thanks and praise to God for His faithfulness and provision.

#### Pray for the church, locally and globally:

- For our staff and pastors as they lead and make decisions for our church.
- For Christian missionaries throughout the world.
- For those who don't know Jesus yet, but find their hearts stirred by spiritual curiosities and eternal longings, and that God would lead them to salvation.
- That we, as followers of Jesus, would be open and willing to share our faith with those who are seeking.

Pray for the effects of COVID-19:

- For those who are sick, and their families, that the Lord would heal and comfort them.
- For first responders and frontline health care workers, as well as for transit workers, police officers, and other public servants.
- For nursing homes, rehabilitation centers, and other long-term care facilities where the residents may be lonely, and their family members are affected too.
- For those involved with politics at every level, that our leaders would work collaboratively and communicate efficiently, setting aside self-interest for the common good.
- For those who have lost work, and those who are anxious about the economic future, including business leaders making difficult decisions.
- For students who are learning from home, and their parents, that the Lord would give them patience and discipline/motivation.
- For graduates and others who have been affected by the cancellation of significant events.
