Jesus – John 18:36a

Read John 18:36-37.

- Since Jesus' kingdom is not of this world, how is it different than a kingdom that is of this world?

Read Colossians 2:6-15.

- What do you think it means to “walk in him,” and to be “rooted and built up in him?” What things help you do this? What temptations or distractions keep you from walking in Him?
