



## **Message Reflections**

January 24, 2021

***“You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek you; I thirst for you, my whole being longs for you, in a dry and parched land where there is no water.” Psalm 63:1***

In the message today we heard about David's heart desire for God. His difficult life circumstances didn't extinguish his worship of the Lord.

Maybe like David, you've found yourself in a “wilderness.” Seasons of weariness, dryness, waiting, uncertainty, or just plain wandering with no clear direction, can all feel like a wilderness. I've learned that we'll never be satisfied in this life—NEVER—unless we're satisfied with God alone.

**Read Psalm 63:1-8.** (Read through 3x and reflect on the words and phrases.)

- Think of the times you have been deeply moved in worship. What was happening in your life at that time? What was going on in worship?
- Come before God with an open and listening ear. Write the question, **“What do I value most?”** at the top of a piece of paper and take time to answer it. **What do you notice? How might your worship need to change?**
- Think of one way in which you will “worship God” differently this week.

As you've taken time to reflect and consider how you worship, I hope today you are able to say with David, *“You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek you.”*
