PRAYER WALK



WHAT IS A PRAYER WALK?

A prayer walk is a way to pray a blessing on the community and focus on the needs of others by interceding for them. It involves walking throughout your neighborhood and/or community while you pray, which helps visualize what God wants to do in the lives of the people who live and work there. Seeing enhances our praying.

HOW DO I PRAY ON A PRAYER WALK?

A prayer walk is a Spirit led time of prayer, where we listen to the Holy Spirit (pay attention) to the needs that He wishes to show us in our neighborhood. The walk can be done on your own or with others, you may pray silently or out loud, stop along the way, or pray as you walk.

WHAT DO I PRAY FOR?

- BLESSING-

Call on the goodness of God to show His favor on your neighborhood by blessing the households you pass and ask for God's peace within those homes as you walk. (Luke 4:16-19; 10:5-6)

- SALVATION -


Ask God to make the presence of Jesus real to every household within your neighborhood. (Luke 10:21-22; John 15:26-27; 1 Corinthians 2:9-10)

- PROTECTION FROM SPIRITUAL WARFARE -

Declare the truth and pray protection for your neighborhood against the powers of darkness and evil. (Ephesians 6:10-18; Matthew 11:12; Matthew 16:18-19; 2 Corinthians 10:3-5)
