THE BIG PICTURE:

Romans 12 is a summary of what a fully-devoted (mature) follower of Jesus looks like.

Read through the whole chapter devotionally, as if you were reading it for your daily quiet time. Pause after each section to think about each aspect of your relationships.

Romans 12:1 - Consider your relationship with God and His mercy.

- What is one of God's mercies that you have seen in your own life?

Romans 12:2 - Consider your relationship to this world's values.

- How do you know whether or not you are conforming to this world?

Romans 12:3-8 - Consider your relationship to yourself and how God has wired you.

- What do you think your gifts are? How do you use them?

Romans 12:9-13 - Consider your relationship with other Christians.

- What keeps you from actively loving others? What barriers or obstacles stand in your way?

Romans 12:14-21 - Consider your relationship with unbelievers.

- What does overcoming evil with good look like?

As you finish your time of reflection on Romans 12, take a moment and thank God for His mercy for you.
