The point of the book of Revelation is to offer real comfort and encouragement. It was for the Christians in John's own day, to whom He wrote, and for every age of the church since that day. It comforts and encourages us as we seek to be faithful to Jesus in a hostile and unbelieving environment.

Read: Revelation 11

Reflect:

- Christ has already taken His kingdom and will reign forever. What parts of Revelation 11:15-18 stir you most deeply?
- How do you engage the suffering in your life: as something to be resisted, or as something that God can use to transform you and others, or as some combination of the two?
- Every believer is to be light. The world we live in is also a dark place. Are you being a witness for the Lord? Are you shining the light from the lampstand or covering it up in fear?

God will make "all things right." Revelation 11 is a reminder that even though things may look bad or like the enemy is winning, God is VICTORIOUS. He will get the victory in the end!

Pray:

- Bring every troublesome element of your life to Christ. For each problem, make the bold prayer "Jesus, I know that you are Lord over _____." Surrender each problem to Him to deal with in His power and in His time.
- Consider what you have learned that might lead you to praise God, repent of sin, and trust more deeply in His gracious promises.
