Read: Revelation 15:4-16:21

Reflect: Jesus counsels us with these words:

"Look, I come like a thief! Blessed is the one who stays awake and remains clothed, so as not to go naked and be shamefully exposed."

Revelation 16:15

- What does it mean practically for you to live in a watchful way, fully clothed in the righteousness of Christ? How would you use this verse to communicate the urgency of the gospel to an unbeliever?

Read: Romans 1:18-20

- Can you think of situations recently where you are tempted to actively suppress the truth of God in order to justify doing something sinful?
- How can you embrace God's truth and promise of mercy in those moments so that you act in accordance with righteousness and experience God's mercy and forgiveness?

Case Study: Some people claim God is too good and loving to punish evil people or send them to Hell. How would you respond, based on what you have learned so far in the Revelation series?

Pray: Pray that you would be energized by the Spirit to live and serve in the present, while keeping your hope for the future.
